Fellowship status provides further benefits beyond full membership, including an @cartography email address, an annual event led by experts and use of the post-nominal FBCartS

Am I eligible?

- A. The standard pathway** application for Fellowship is open to BCS members who can demonstrate:
1. At least two years continuous commitment to the society as an individual member.
 2. A minimum of five years' experience in cartography or geodata visualisation related activities, production, management, research, curation or time spent in higher education
 3. All applications need a proposer and a seconder. These could include Council Members, Fellows, BCS Members of at least five years' standing, or a person with seniority or professional status.

- B. The 25-year unbroken membership pathway** for Fellowship is open to individuals with 25 years unbroken membership of the BCS who are automatically eligible for Fellowship status.
