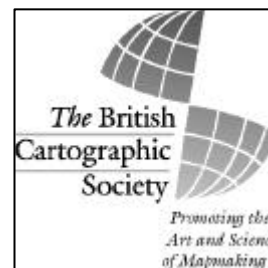


Members' Questionnaire & Gift Aid Declaration

I am a UK taxpayer. I would like the British Cartographic Society (BCS) to treat all membership subscriptions and donations I have made from 6 April 2000 as Gift Aid donations until I notify you otherwise. Signing this Declaration will cost you nothing and brings much needed revenue to the Society.

NOTES

1. Your declaration covers donations (including membership subscriptions) you may make in the future.
 - Please notify BCS Administration (address below) if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying BCS Administration — it will then not apply to membership subscriptions you pay on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. You must pay an amount of UK income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the BCS reclaims on your subscriptions and donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give). If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the BCS reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you are unsure whether your subscriptions or donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please contact BCS Administration at the address below. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.
